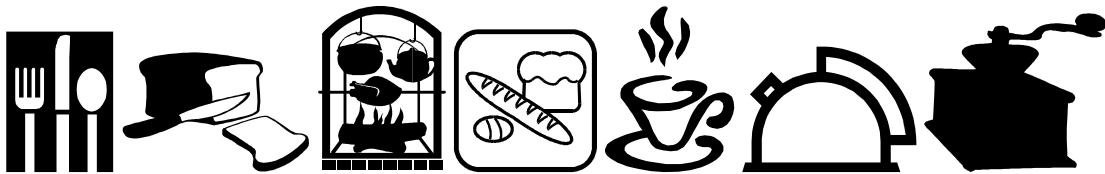


Lets Eat! Scavenger Hunt

1. What types of food would the Occaneechi Indians have ground with mortar and pestle in the *Road to Orange* exhibit?
2. Can you think of two foods that are made of ground corn?
3. What food is made with the thing that has a rectangle attached to a long handle and is sitting in front of the fireplace? Hint: it's a breakfast treat!
4. There is no stove in the *Colonial/Revolutionary Women* exhibit. Where did they cook food?

5. Name two substitutes for coffee used during the Civil War, as shown in *The Wrath to Come* exhibit.

6. Who made the two soup ladles on display in the silver case?

7. The big copper still under the window next to the organ is used to make what drink?
